his past spring, twenty-three designers of color converged on Lenox, Massachusetts's Cornell Inn for The Kaleidoscope Project. The designers reimagined the rooms and suites in the bed-and-breakfast's three eighteenth- and nineteenth-century buildings. Common areas such as the lobby, bar, and dining room received face-lifts, too. The project resulted in modern, sexy, and sometimes thought-provoking spaces just steps

from downtown Lenox and a short drive from Tanglewood. If you missed touring Kaleidoscope, don't fret—the twenty-eight-room B&B reopened to visitors in June, so you can enjoy all of the charms of summer in the Berkshires in one of the redesigned spaces. Pro tip: book a room with a balcony to enjoy the property's four acres of gardens and water features.
